

## Loving Reconciliation (v 11-13)





## Living Temple (v14-17)

#### 2 Corinthians 14a and 16b

Do not be yoked together with unbelievers... For we are the temple of the living God.

Do not be yoked together with unbelievers. (v14a)



Do not plow with an ox and a donkey yoked together. Deut 22:10

## Some of Paul's examples

Unbeliever's home: If invited to the home of an unbeliever, a believer is free to attend. (1 Cor 10:27)

Christian meetings: Unbelievers were not forbidden to attend the Christian meetings. (1 Cor 14:22-25)


#### 2 Corinthians 6:18

Perfecting holiness out of reverence for God (NIV)


in the fear of God (NASB)
