








God's Timing is Perfect!



Who is James?

- Half-brother of Jesus
- Jewish Believer
- Leader and Teacher
- Servant of God and the Lord Jesus Christ.



What is a Servant?

- Man serving man usually implies quid pro quo.
- Servant of God seeks to serve even if the other one is unresponsive and resentful.
- We are to sow seeds, and the Spirit enables the growth.
- Servants of God have love in their hearts and their primary obligation is to God.

About A.D. 49 before Ephesians

Who were the recipients of James' letter?

- Jewish believers living around the Mediterranean in the Roman world.
- Scattered due to persecution.
- Since there is no mention of any personal experience
 James had with his readers or a messenger, we
 assume he does not know them.
- They grew up observing the law and the customs of the Jewish faith plus believing that Jesus is the Messiah.
- They thought the seat of authority was in Jerusalem, the heart of Jewish Christianity.

- God provides


We are to love and serve others.
