




You shall not steal!

#### Deprivation of Property

- Who does the property belong to?
  - Communists say: the state
  - Capitalists say: the individual
  - Bible says: the Lord (*The earth is the Lord's and everything in it.* Psalm 24:1)
- Therefore, when you rob people of property, you sin against God.

#### Deprivation of Liberty

 This is kidnapping. In the Bible, it's punishable by death not restitution.

#### Deprivation of Dignity

- This is smearing a reputation and character.
- This is done through libel, slander, or defamation of character.
- God invested us with honorable character.

#### **Deprivation of Opportunity**

- When you steal from your employer, you deprive him/her of their right to make a profit. Often, the cost is absorbed by the costumers.
- When you call in sick and you aren't, you rob him/her of his right to get a full day's work for a full day's wage. This includes arriving late, leaving early, and taking long breaks.
- Cheating on taxes is stealing from the government. (Luke 20:25)

#### **Deprivation of Necessities**

- Stealing is not giving someone what you owe them.
- Stealing is looking on suffering people and doing nothing. The have's have a responsibility to help the have-not's.
- Stealing is denying the needy an opportunity to survive.

#### **Contradictory Behaviors**

- When our mouths say one thing and our actions say another, we steal from God, because we do not give the right message to people.
- We rob God of God's credibility by our inconsistent behavior.

#### **Not Giving**

 When we do not give our tithes and offerings, it's stealing. (Malachi 3:7-10)


## Dangers of Stealing

1. The thief will get in trouble with the law and the Law.



- 2. Stealing can ruin relationships with others.
- 3. Stealing leads to deception and lies.
- 4. It harms the thief morally and emotionally.
- 5. Stealing often times burdens others.
- 6. The victims may feel violated, fearful, or angry. Trusting others is affected.
- 7. It can hinder the work of the Lord.

- 3. The recipients receive hope.


