



JESUS HEALS

JESUS HEALS

- 31 instances of healing by Jesus are described in the Gospels
- Synoptic Gospels describe the same 8 healings of individuals and 2 mass healings
- John says that that "Jesus did many other signs in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book." John 20:30

The Gospels report 7 Sabbath healing events by Jesus



Luke records more of the Sabbath controversies than any other Gospel writer.

It's Not About the Healings It's Not About the Sabbath

It's About Who Jesus Is

THE FOURTH COMMANDMENT

Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy.

Six days you shall labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is a Sabbath to the Lord your God.

On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your manservant or maidservant, nor your animals, nor the alien within your gates.

For in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, but he rested on the seventh day. Therefore the Lord blessed the Sabbath day and made it holy.

Exodus 20: 8-11

Importance of Sabbath Keeping

- Exodus 31: Sabbath keeping declared a sign of the Mosaic Covenant, death penalty for violators
- OT prophets warned persistent disregard of Sabbath would lead to expulsion from the land and captivity

Importance of Sabbath Keeping

 During 400 years between testaments, scholars and religious leaders expanded interpretation of the Sabbath

Israel dominated by foreign powers during this time

Putting on a piece of jewelry?

Lighting a fire?

What is "Work"?

Moving a lamp from one table to another?


Picking up your child?

The Pharisees saw the essence of the 4th commandment as "Thou shalt not work".

Jesus saw the essence of the 4th commandment as "Remember the Sabbath Day to keep it holy."

Picking Grain on the Sabbath

Luke 6: 1-5

Who was accused of wrongdoing?

NOT JESUS, BUT HIS DISCIPLES

WHY?

To force Jesus to either agree with the interpretation of the Pharisees, or condone the action of His disciples, thereby challenging the authority of the Jewish religious leaders.

- Mosaic law didn't forbid picking the grain on the Sabbath
- But the Jewish collections of interpretations did
- Jesus' response assumes this was "work" and banned under the Sabbath law.

WHAT DID JESUS' RESPONSE MEAN?

The Sabbath is meant to teach about sanctification, not to cause hardship.

"The Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath"


Jesus IS God

If God established the Sabbath, then Jesus, as God, has the authority to interpret what it means

Healing the Withered Hand

Pharisees objected BEFORE Jesus did it

Jesus points out the double standard in their interpretation



Luke 6: 6-11

Jesus' Defense of Healing on the Sabbath

- He is the Son of God (John 5: 16-17)
- He is greater than the temple (Matt. 12:6)
- He is greater than David
 (Matt. 12:8, Luke 6:3-5, Mark 2: 28)
