



1863 - 1947

Ford's Innovations that revolutionized American Society and molded the world were the Model T and the Assembly Line.





Ford's Assembly Line reduced the cost of the Model T and offered jobs.


1908: Model T \$825

- Go! Work for Jesus








The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want. He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters.
